Il tema gode di una rilevante attenzione politica ed è stato affrontato in maniera diversa in molti Paesi.

Le innovazioni introdotte dalla Commissione Europea in tema di *Better Regulation* hanno conferito un afflato sovra-nazionale alla questione, così da favorire il ravvicinamento della *policy* dell'Unione Europea a quelle di Paesi extra-UE ed al lavoro di organizzazioni sovranazionali.

La prospettiva del confronto tra approcci ed esperienze internazionali è uno degli obiettivi principali del Convegno. I relatori esamineranno i differenti aspetti legati all'applicazione dei principi di *Better Regulation*, intesa in senso comunitario, con particolare riferimento ai tre pilastri della **consultazione degli stakeholders**, della **semplificazione della legislazione** e della **realizzazione di studi di impatto regolamentare**. Verranno anche presentate le esperienze di alcuni paesi europei che hanno dato priorità alla realizzazione della *Regulatory Reform* nazionale.

Le relazioni saranno presentate da esperti di diversa provenienza: Commissione Europea, OCSE, Better Regulation Executive e Financial Services Authority britannici, Better Regulation Unit tedesca, Commerce Agency danese. E' prevista la partecipazione di rappresentanti del Governo, delle autorità regolamentari e del settore bancario italiani.
